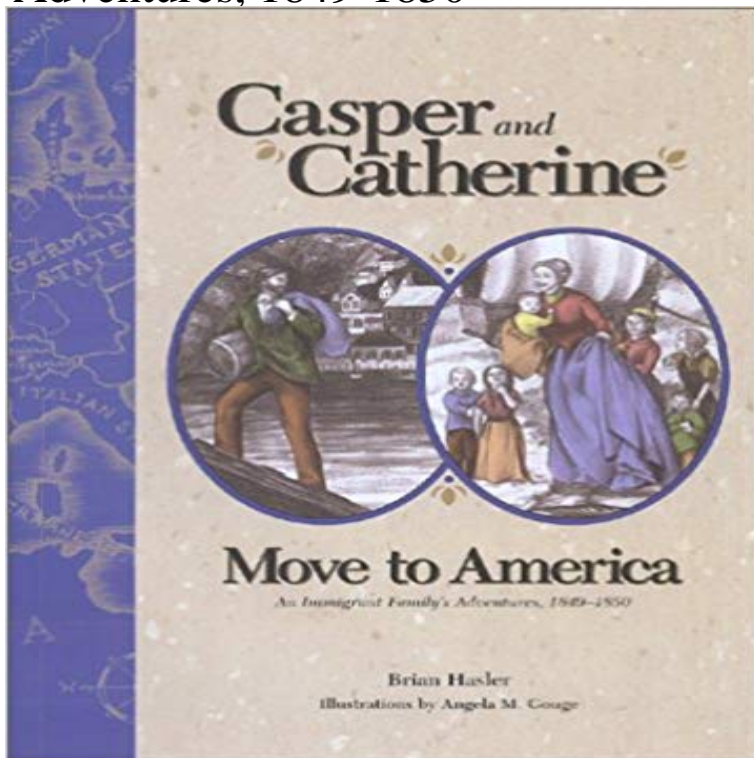


Casper and Catherine Move to America: An Immigrant Family's Adventures, 1849-1850
