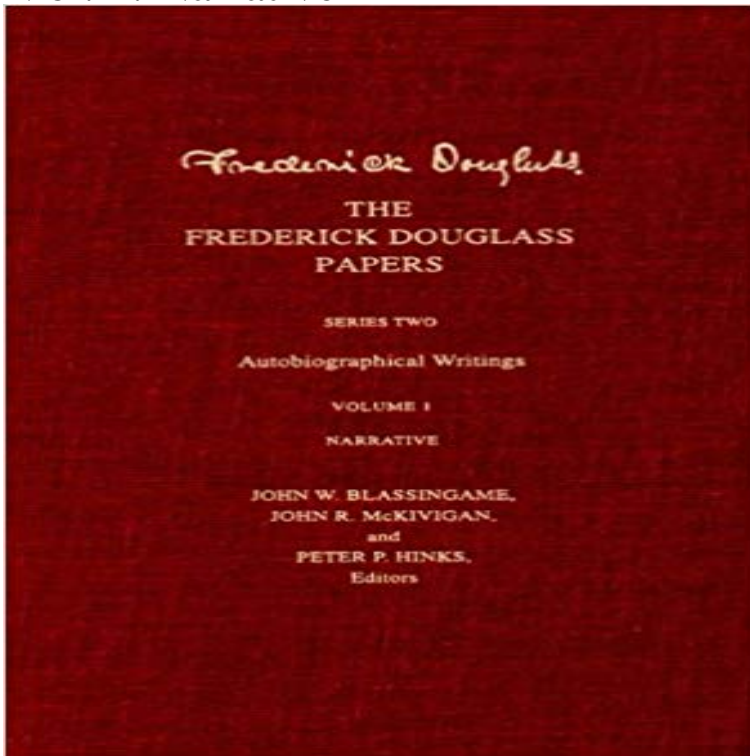


The Frederick Douglass Papers, Series 2: Autobiographical Writings, Vol. 1: Narrative
