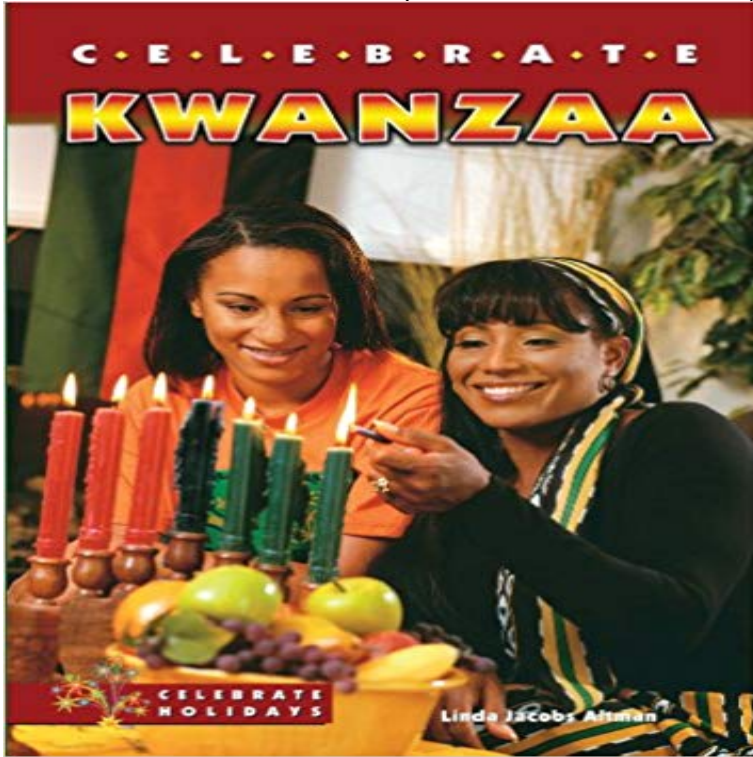


Celebrate Kwanzaa (Celebrate Holidays)
