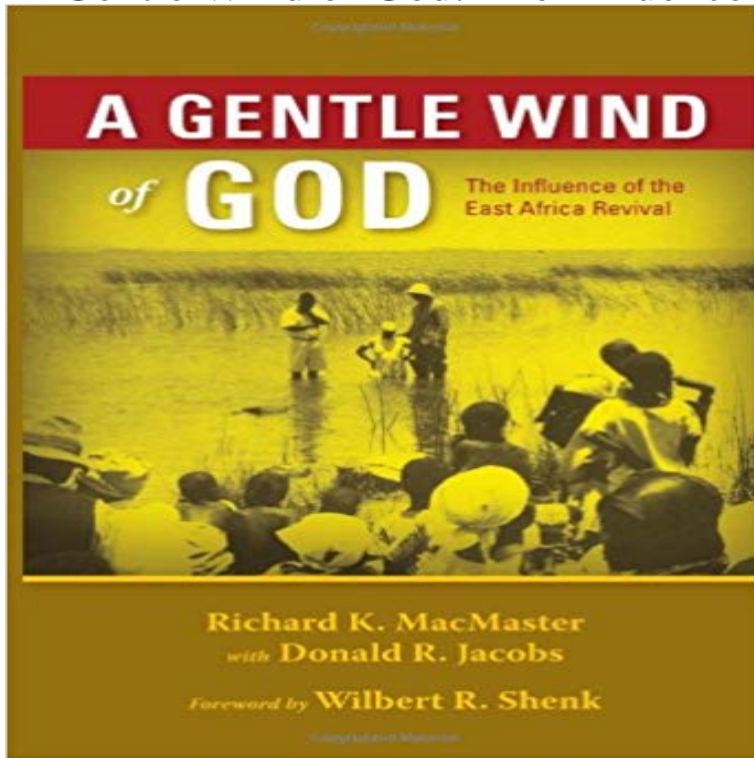


A Gentle Wind of God: The Influence of the East Africa Revival
