

This work argues that many early Christian quotations of the Old Testament derive not from scriptural manuscripts, but rather authoritative written testimonia collections developed to support basic Christian beliefs. Combining patristic studies (notably on Justin and Barnabas) and evidence from Qumran with detailed examination of quotations in the New Testament, the book builds a fresh case for a neglected scholarly hypothesis. After reviewing the scholarly literature and Jewish and Greco-Roman analogous literary collections, the book presents a comprehensive overview extant testimonia traditions from the second to the fourth century C.E. The final chapters argue for the use of written testimonia collections in the New Testament. This offers solid evidence for remarkably unified early Christian scriptural tradition that extended throughout the Mediterranean world.
