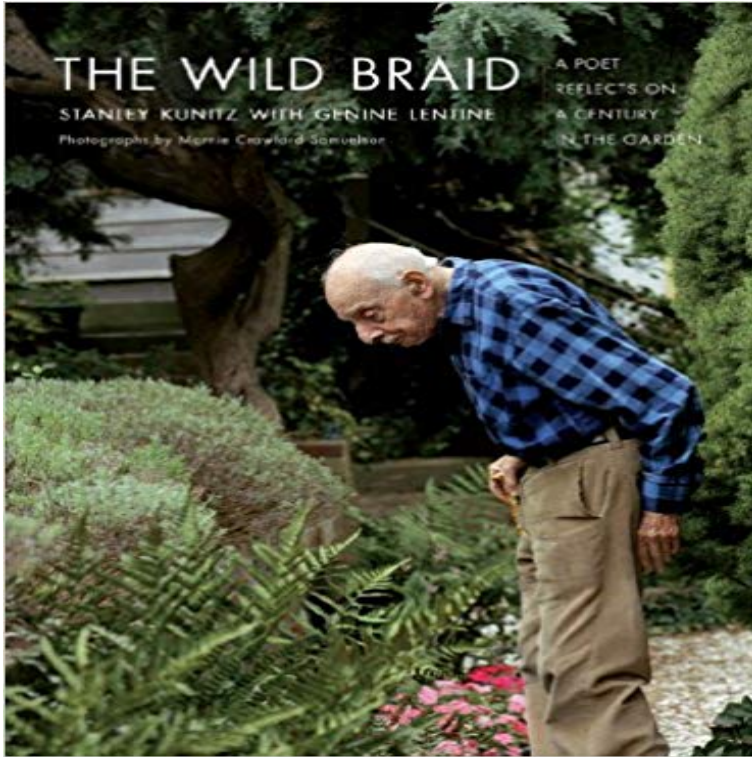


The Wild Braid: A Poet Reflects on a Century in the Garden
