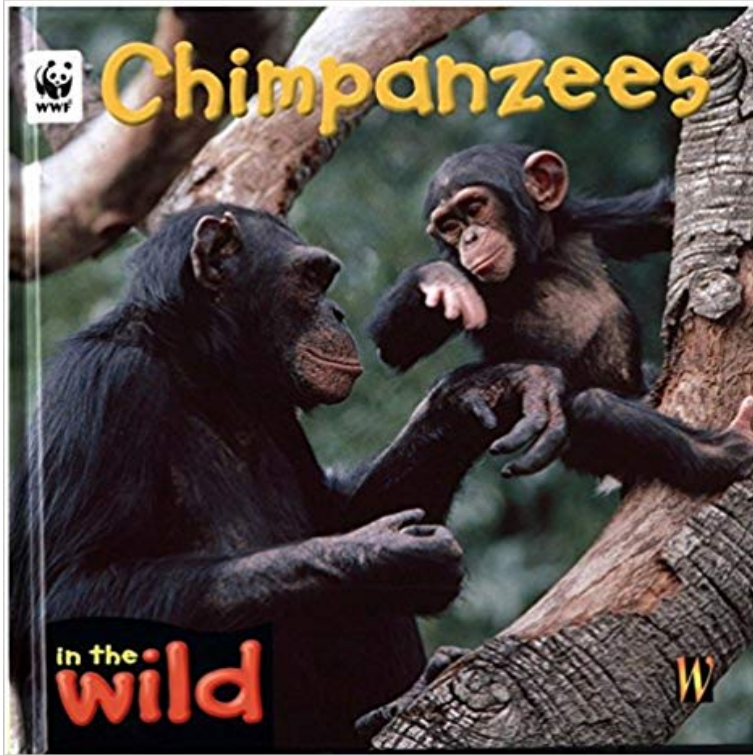


Chimpanzees (In the Wild)
